
The freestanding applique instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same. All designs are stitched with matching thread, top and bobbin.


Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

STEP 1

DOUBLE SIDED FREESTANDING APPLIQUE

- Adhere one layer of StabilStick CutAway to the wrong side of all applique fabrics to provide stiffness to the finished structure.
- Cut the prepared applique fabrics 1/4"-1/2" larger than the templates that are included at the end of the instructions.







STEP 2


DOUBLE SIDED FREESTANDING APPLIQUE

 Hoop one layer of AquaMesh and one layer of BadgeMaster for all designs.




STEP 3

- Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is HG259_48.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Match the bobbin thread to the upper thread throughout.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Placement Stitch.



- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared applique fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.





STEP 5

DOUBLE SIDED FREESTANDING APPLIQUE

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.



- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.
- Tip: If the stabilizer is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric, use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway as a patch.





STEP 7

DOUBLE SIDED FREESTANDING APPLIQUE

- Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the machine steps 3-5, per the thread chart.
- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and place the prepared applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the design.
- Carefully tape to secure.
 Tip: Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.





- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 6, Back Cut Line and Tackdown.





STEP 9

DOUBLE SIDED FREESTANDING APPLIQUE

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.




STEP 10

- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch the remaining machine steps per the thread chart with matching bobbin thread.



STEP 11

• When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4"- 1/2" outside the design.





STEP 12

DOUBLE SIDED FREESTANDING APPLIQUE

- Rinse each piece in warm running water until the design is only slightly tacky.
- Place right side down on a non-stick surface to dry. Using parchment paper or a cooling rack work well to prevent curling. Dry completely.
- Once dry, press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.




STEP 13

 Use the OESD Mini MAT and Punch Tool with the 3mm attachment to create the eyelets.
 Tip: Take care to not cut the satin stitching.



STEP 14

 Use the OESD Alligator Clamps to insert and fasten the ribbon for hanging.







STEP 15

DOUBLE SIDED FREESTANDING APPLIQUE

Your ornament is complete. Enjoy!






STEP 16

CALENDAR POCKETS

- Press 2 tea towels.
- Set one aside.
- Cut one of the towels into 4 equal strips by the width of the towel. Strips will be approximately 7" x 20".



- Press each strip wrong sides together to form a 3.5" x 20" strip.
- Unfold and mark 1.5" down from the fold line.








STEP 18

CALENDAR POCKETS

- Find the center of the strip, approximately 10" from the sides.
- Measure 1.5" to either side of the center and mark.
- Measure and mark 3" from each of those marks, and 3" again from those marks.
- · These are the centers for each number.
- Note: Tea Towels will be approximately 20" wide.
 There will be six numbers on each strip.



- Hoop one layer of StabilStick TearAway paper (shiny) side up.
- Use the OESD Perfect Scoring Tool to score the paper.
- Remove the paper to reveal the adhesive surface.





STEP 20

CALENDAR POCKETS

- Place one strip of fabric in the hoop.
- Choose a font style from the built-in machine fonts.
- Type in the number 1.
- Use the machine features to align the design with the center marking for the number "1".
- Stitch the design.
- Continue adding numbers and aligning with the center markings.
- Numbers 1-6 will be on the first strip of fabric.





- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and gently tear away the stabilizer from around the design.
- Gently tear away the excess stabilizer.
- Press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.
- Continue stitching numbers on all four sets of pockets.





STEP 22

- Fold each pocket in half right sides together, matching raw edges.
- Sew a ½" seam on the long edge.
- Turn right side out and press.
- Set them aside.





STEP 23

CALENDAR MARKING

- Draw a line across each short end of the second tea towel. The lines will be 1.5" from the edges.
- Note: This line will be where the hems will be turned and stitched.
- Choose one short end to be the top of the advent calendar.
- · Mark the center with a vertical line.
- Mark a horizontal line 7" down from the hem line.
 This is the embroidery area you have to work with.

STEP 24

- Adhere one layer of StabilStick CutAway to the wrong side of all applique fabrics to provide stiffness to the finished structure.
- Cut the prepared applique fabrics 1/4"-1/2" larger than the templates that are included at the end of the instructions.



STEP 25

- · Print the designs on StabilStick Template Sheets.
- Trim template sheets approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ " outside the design.
- Use the StabilStick Templates to audition design placement.
- Peel the paper backing from the template.
- Align and place templates.
 - Tip: Save the paper to put the template back onto. Templates are reusable.

Tip: Press the template on clothes to remove excess tackiness.





STEP 26

- · Hoop one layer of StabilStick TearAway paper (shiny) side up.
- Use the OESD Perfect Scoring Tool to score the paper.
- Remove the paper to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Place the tea towel on the StabilStick aligning the marks on the tea towel with the center marks on the hoop.
- Finger press to secure.





- Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is HG281_48.
- · Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- · Place the hoop on the machine.
- Use machine placement features to verify design placement with the template.
- IMPORTANT: Gently remove the template before stitching. DO NOT STITCH THROUGH THE TEMPLATE.





STEP 28

Stitch Machine Step 1, Placement Stitch.



STEP 29

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared applique fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.





STEP 31

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.



STEP 32

 Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the remaining machine steps, per the thread chart.



- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and gently tear away the stabilizer from around the design.
- Continue the applique process until all designs have been stitched.



PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER



STEP 34

- Mark a line 1.5" from each end.
- · Fold and press hem.
- Hem each end 1" from the folded edge.
- Mark a line 1.5" from the folded edge.
- This will be the placement mark for the bottom of the 17-24 pocket.





- Align the bottom of the 17-24 pocket with the drawn line.
- Topstitch along the bottom edge and the sides.



PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER



STEP 36

- Mark 1" from the top of the pocket and place the bottom edge of the next pocket along that line.
- Topstitch along the bottom edge and the sides.
- Continue marking 1" up from each pocket and adding the pockets.





- Measure equal distances between the numbers and mark lines through all the pockets.
- Topstitch each pocket.



PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER



STEP 38

- Add a dowel to each hemmed edge.
- Cut ribbon to desired size and tie to each end of the top dowel.



STEP 39

· Place an ornament in each pocket.


