#### Notes

The mug wrap instructions included in the design pack are general instructions for the designs. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same. The sample design is 12958-01.

**Note:** Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

#### **STEP 1**

- Print the mirrored version of the templates (at 100% or 1:1 ratio) onto the paper side of Applique Fuse and Fix.
- Cut approximately ¼" ½" outside the printed applique templates.



#### STEP 2

- Fuse the trimmed templates to the wrong side of the appropriate applique fabric with the paper side of the printed template up.
- Hold the iron on the template for 10-15 seconds for a secure fuse.





### STEP 3

- Trim the prepared appliques on the outer edge of the black outline.
- Set aside.



#### STEP 4

• Hoop one layer of Medium Weight TearAway.



#### STEP 5

- Load the selected design into the machine.
- Example design is 12958-01.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Felt Placement Stitch.





### STEP 6

- Remove the hoop from the machine but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place hoop on a flat surface.
- On the back of the applique fabric, score and remove the paper backing to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Place the applique fabric within the placement stitching.
- Finger press to secure.
   Note: Applique Fuse and Fix is repositionable.

### STEP 7

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Felt Tackdown.







### STEP 8

• Stitch Machine Step 3, Felt Placement Stitch.



### STEP 9

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- On the back of the applique fabric, score and remove the paper backing to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Place the applique fabric within the placement stitching.
- Finger press to secure.

#### STEP 10

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Felt Tackdown.







• Stitch Machine Step 5, Felt Placement Stitch.





### **STEP 12**

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- On the back of the applique fabric, score and remove the paper backing to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Place the applique fabric within the placement stitching.
- Finger press to secure.

#### STEP 13

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 6, Felt Tackdown.







• Stitch Machine Steps 7 and 8.





### STEP 15

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over.
- Cut a piece of elastic 4" long.
- Fold the elastic in half and position on the placement line as shown, with the fold of the elastic outside of the design.
- Tape the elastic outside of the design.



#### **STEP 16**

- On the back of the applique fabric, score and remove the paper backing to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Place the applique fabric within the placement stitching.
- Finger press gently. Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



### STEP 17

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 9, Seam Stitch and Button Mark.






### **STEP 18**

- Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop.
- Remove the excess stabilizer.



#### **STEP 19**

• Attach a button over the button placement stitch.





• The mug wrap is complete!

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
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#### **TO SAVE PAPER**


Only print the desired image by navigating to the image's page, go to File > Print and select "Current page" in the print dialog box. Repeat for each desired image.

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


























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







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





























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
