

Product Usage Instructions













IMPORTANT:

NOT TO BE USED AS A STABILIZER REMOVE BEFORE STITCHING FOR PLACEMENT ONLY

- Load sheets into printer to print on the stabilizer side (not the paper side).
- Print design template at 100% size and with a crosshair in the center. (PHOTO 1)
- Mark an arrow for the top of design on the template, if not printed. Trim away excess StabilStick from around the design. (PHOTO 2)
- Remove paper covering to expose adhesive surface on the back of the template. Position on garment, quilt, or other fabric to be embroidered. Audition placement options if desired. The template remains sticky for multiple uses! (PHOTO 3)
- Hoop the fabric with the template(s) in place. (PHOTO 4, PHOTO 5)
- Rotate the design if necessary. Position the hoop so that the needle is over the crosshair. Trace the design if necessary. (PHOTO 6)
- Gently remove the template from the fabric. Then, press Start to stitch a perfectly placed design. DO NOT STITCH THROUGH THE TEMPLATE.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- When positioning designs on a garment, try the garment on. StabilStick Template Sheets stay put when handling the fabric and won't come off until removed.
- When using multiple small templates, print them out on plain paper, trim and position on a blank sheet of paper. Copy onto a StabilStick Template Sheet with a copier. (PHOTO 7, PHOTO 8)
- Make notes about the design on the template itself i.e. design name/number, mirror image, etc.
- Score across the paper side of a template with a straight pin then bend to make the paper easy to remove.
