#### PK10020-01

- Cream cotton fabric
  - (1) 7" x 12" envelope enclosure
  - (1) 7" x 6" envelope enclosure
  - (1) 7" x 8" front
- Purple cotton fabric
  - (1) 4" x 6.5"

#### PK10020-02

- Pink cotton fabric
  - (1) 7" x 12" envelope enclosure
  - (1) 7" x 6" envelope enclosure
  - (1) 7" x 8" front





#### PK10020-03

- Cream cotton fabric
  - (1) 7" x 12" envelope enclosure
  - (1) 7" x 6" envelope enclosure
  - (1) 7" x 8" front
- Purple cotton fabric
  - $(1) 3.5" \times 3.5"$
- Pink cotton fabric
  - $(1) 5" \times 2"$

#### PK10020-04

- Purple cotton fabric
  - (1) 7" x 12" envelope enclosure
  - (1) 7" x 6" envelope enclosure
  - (1) 7" x 8" front
- Pink cotton fabric
  - $(1) 3" \times 6"$



#### **General Instructions**

The mug rug instructions included in the design pack are general instructions for the designs. For demonstration purposes, the following instructions are for a sample design that best demonstrates the techniques. Refer to the thread chart for each specific design.

The sample design is 10020-03.

**Note:** Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

#### Step 1

- Fuse a layer of Fuse and Fleece to the wrong size of the 7" x 8" cream fabric.
- Fold the remaining cream fabrics (7" x 12" and 7" x 6") in half, wrong sides together.
- Press.

**Note:** After folding  $7'' \times 12''$  will measure approximately  $7'' \times 6''$ .

After folding 7" x 6" will measure approximately 7" x 3".



- Hoop one layer of Medium Weight TearAway.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- · Load the design.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.



# EMBROIDERY OF




### Step 3

 Stitch Machine Step 1, Batting and Cream Fabric Placement Stitch.



### Step 4

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place on a flat surface.
- With a pen, extend the placement lines on each side of the rectangle to the edge of the hoop as shown.



- Position the background fabric (cream fabric backed with Fuse and Fleece) right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.





#### Step 6

- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Batting and Cream Fabric Tackdown.



#### Step 7

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the cream background fabric about 1/8" outside of the tackdown stitching.



- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Purple Fabric Placement Stitch.





#### Step 9

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



#### Step 10

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Cut Line and Tackdown.



### Step 11

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line stitching as possible.

**Note:** If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.





### Step 12

- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 5, Pink Fabric Placement Stitch.



#### Step 13

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared fabric.
- · Tape in place to secure.



- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 6, Cut Line and Tackdown.





### Step 15

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line stitching as possible.



- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 7-12, changing thread per thread chart.
- · Stop before stitching the last machine step.




# EMBROIDERY OF



#### Step 17

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Position the smaller folded fabric (7" x 3" folded) over the bottom of the design, aligning the folded edge with the top side placement line as shown.
- Position the larger folded fabric (7" x 6" folded) over the top of the design aligning the folded edge with the bottom side placement line so that the two fabrics overlap.
- Tape in place to secure.
  - **Tip:** By overlapping the two fabrics in the listed order, it will prevent the embroidery foot from catching on the overlapped edge of the fabric.





#### Step 18

· Stitch Machine Step 13, Seam.



# **ASSEMBLY**



#### Step 19

- Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop.
- · Tear away excess stabilizer.
- Trim the outer edges 1/4" from the seam stitch on all four sides.
- Clip each corner diagonally.



#### Step 20

- Turn the project right side out.
- Use the Expert Point and Press Tool to push out the corners and side seams.
- Press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.



#### Step 21

The mug rug is complete!




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
