

# Stitch and Turn Cat Toys

#PK50038 4 DESIGNS

## MATERIALS



#### **Isacord Thread Colors**

0010 Silky White

0020 Black

0131 Smoke

0630 Buttercup

1102 Pumpkin

Note: One spool of 1000 meter thread is adequate for the project unless otherwise noted.

### MATERIALS



- OESD PolyMesh CutAway
- OESD Top Cover Permanent Topping Variety Pack
- OESD Applique Fuse and Fix
- OESD Fuse and Seal (1/4" by width of the opening)

#### Fabrics/Textiles

- Assorted colors Minkie fabric 2 of each required for front & back
- Grey Minkine Fabric 6"x4" x2
- Blue Minkie Fabric 7.5" x 5" x2
- Yellow Minkie Fabric 6"x5.5" x2
- Orange Minkie Fabric -7" x 4.5" x2

Assorted matching felt colors & minkie for applique Note: Fabric sizes are estimates and may result in overage.

Cord/Ribbon

Squid - Blue cord (3 even sections)

Squid - Blue Ribbon (3 even sections)

Mouse-Brown cord

- OESD Expert Embroidery Tape **TearAway**
- OESD Expert Point and Press Tool
- OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth Fiberfill stuffing


### PIECING DIAGRAMS















#### Notes

- The stitch & turn instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Example Collection is 51206 -Halloween Minkee Misfits
- Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same. All designs are stitched with matching thread, top and bobbin.
  Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.




### Step 1

- Fabric Requirements:
  - (2) Pieces 7.5" x 6" of Minkee fabric in desired color. (8 pieces of rick rack cut to 5" each for legs).
- Hoop one layer of OESD PolyMesh CutAway stabilizer.
- Stitch the first color called Placement Stitch. Use a thread color that blends with your fabric choice.



#### Step 2

 Cut a 7.5"x 6" piece of Minkee for the first placement stitch being sure that the Placement Stitch is covered by the fabric.





### Step 3

- Lay the StitcH2O topper over the fabric and tape in place with Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway.
- Raise the presser foot if possible to accommodate the added loft of the fabric. If not, slow the machine speed.
- Stitch the second color, the Tackdown Stitch.



#### Step 4

 Sew the rest of the colors on the design and stop after you sew Rick Rack tackdown stitch.



#### Step 5

- Cut 8 pieces of Rick Rack 5" and Place direction of the placement stitches with the largest part of the Rick Rack on the inside and the smallest section on the outside. Using OESD Expert Embroidery TearAway Tape. Tape the small part of the Rick Rack on the outside of the design making sure the longer piece doesn't go outside the Tackdown Stitch.
- Do the same process for that side and the other side.






#### Step 6

 Sew the next color Rick Rack Tackdown sew this slowly and make sure the Rick Rack don't get hung up on your sewing foot. It should sew over the tape you put on the Rick Rack.




#### Step 7

 Place the second piece of fabric right side down directly over the first piece.



#### Step 8

 Stitch the final color, again using the first thread color, called Seam - Match Top Fabric. (For visual purposes we used a bright color so you could see the seam)






#### Step 9

- Remove the hoop from the machine and the fabric from the hoop.
- Using scissors, carefully cut out the stitch 'n' turn project close to the stitching line and over the small pieces of Rick Rack. Cut around the stitches at the opening to create a tab.




#### Step 10

- · Clip corners as needed.
- Turn the project right side out. Use a point turner or chopstick to turn out corners and curves.




#### Step 11

- Trim any jump stitches and then peel off the StitcH2O topping.
- · Stuff with polyester fiberfill.
- Note: For a smooth project, add small pieces of fiberfill until desired fullness is reached. Use Expert Point and Press tool to move fiberfill into corners.
- Fold tabs in and slip stitch the slit closed with a hand needle, or use a narrow machine zigzag stitch.
