Listings below indicate color sample, stitching order and suggested thread color number. "I" refers to Isacord thread and "T" refers to Timeless thread. Colors beginning with 20501 refer to YLI Fine Metallics, 7 refer to Yenmet Metallic, 8 refer to YLI Variations Variegated Thread and 9 refer to Isacord Multicolor Variegated.

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In the Hoop Hamburger Pouch

Instructions

Now you can create a hamburger shaped zippered pouch in the hoop of your embroidery machine. Use tan colored fabric for the main pouch and brown fabric for the meat. Red, green and light yellow colors of thread are used for the tomato, lettuce, seeds and onions. It is another quick and fun in the hoop project. Enjoy making for a fun gift idea for those who love hamburgers!

Supplies

- OESD embroidery design In the Hoop Hamburger Pouch
- Medium tear away stabilizer
- ¼ yd. tan fabric (pouch)
- 6" x 3" piece brown fabric (meat)
- 3" piece of 5/8" dark brown ribbon (ring tab)
- Metal key ring
- 7" yellow or gold zipper
- Embroidery threads
- Temporary spray adhesive



Cut

- (1) 6" x 4 ½" piece tan fabric (fold in half to measure 6" x 2 ¼") (top bun)
- (1) 6" x 3" piece tan fabric (fold in half to measure 6" x 1 ½") (bottom bun)
- (1) 6" x 9" piece tan fabric (fold in half to measure 6" x 4 ½") (back)
- (1) 6" x 3" piece brown fabric (fold in half to measure 6" x 1 ½") (meat)

Instructions

- Hoop tear away stabilizer.
- Stitch first stitch of embroidery design which is the Zipper Placement Stitch. **Photo 1**
- Using temporary spray adhesive, spray the zipper placement stitch. Center and place zipper over the stitching lines. Stitch the second stitch of embroidery design called Zipper Tackdown.

- Using the meat fabric, fold in half to measure 6" x 1 ½", wrong sides together. Press. Center and place the folded edge to top teeth of zipper leaving at least a ¼" on either end. Change colors of thread and stitch the third stitch called Patty Tackdown. **Photo 3**
- Continue stitching the next couple of colors which are the Tomato and Lettuce. **Photo 4**
- Using the same color of thread as the Lettuce, stitch the Top Bun Placement Stitch. **Photo 5**
- Using top bun and bottom bun fabric pieces, fold in half as indicated in the cut section, wrong sides together. Press. Center and place top bun fabric with folded edge overlapping ¼" the Top



Bun Placement Stitch, leaving at least a 1/4" on either end. Center and place bottom bun fabric with folded edge to bottom teeth of zipper, leaving at least a 1/4" on either end.

- Stitch the next stitch of the embroidery design called Bun Tackdowns. This will stitch top bun and bottom bun fabric sections in place. **Photo 6**
- The next stitch is a color change called the Seeds and Onions. Change colors and stitch. **Photo 7**
- For ring tab: 3" piece of 5/8" dark brown ribbon and metal key ring.

- Fold ribbon in half around metal key ring and use a small amount of spray adhesive to hold ribbon ends together. **Photo 8**. Place folded tab in the upper corner of the top bun, above the zipper, with the looped end and metal key ring inside the Bun Tackdown and the raw ribbon edge outside of the Bun Tackdown.

- Unzip the zipper halfway. Right sides together, place back fabric over design, making sure to cover the entire design. Stitch the final stitch called Seam Stitch and make sure the tab is stitched. This will stitch the sections together. **Photo 9**
- Remove the pouch from the hoop and trim excess stabilizer and fabric. Trim the stabilizer from the zipper. Turn right side out and press.
- Have a fun time making the In the Hoop Hamburger Pouch.
